Jazz Vespers is simply an Evening service using the genre of jazz music to create a space where as a congregation we may worship God. Jazz is one of the ultimate creative art forms around. Each musician responds to the music with spontaneous creativity, built up from many, many years of practice and study.

Jazz Vespers started in 1964 at St. Peter's Lutheran Church in New York. The enterprising Pastor, Revd John Garcia Gensel realised that most musicians couldn't make a Sunday morning service given that they had only got home around 4/5am. To this day, (and yes at 5pm NY time today) a Jazz Vespers service has taken place at St Peter's each Sunday. Members of the jazz community in New York worship together.

Dan Forshaw started a Jazz Vespers ministry whilst he was the Worship Minister at St James' Church in Hemingford Grey, Cambridge and since October 2015 has led regular, bi-monthly Jazz Vespers services at Methodist Central Hall Westminster. Dan is part of the international 'Blue Church' network, (that includes St Peter's Lutheran Church in NYC') that seeks to resource jazz musicians all over the world so that 'Churches can be spaces to encounter improvised music, words and silence. The musical language of Jazz and the world of biblical thought as joint inspiration.'
